IMPORTANT!



'Me too!' Türkçe'de 'ben de' anlamına gelmektedir ancak birisi bize 'nice to meet you' dediği zaman ben de demek istiyorsak 'you too' deriz.

-You too! (Seninle de)

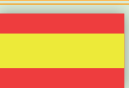
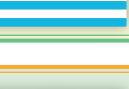

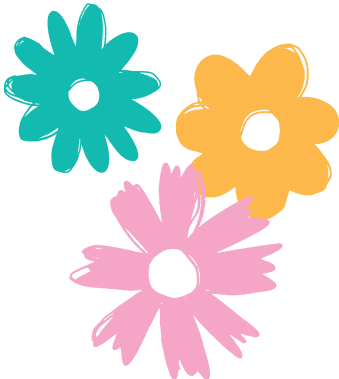
